### Where does my snack money go?

This voluntary contribution goes towards much more than just paying for your child's daily snacks:

## Funding

**2 year olds - Some** children qualify for government funding (15 hours) of free education from the age of two.

**3 & 4 year olds - All** children from the age of three qualify for the universal entitlement (15 hours) of free education.

**Some** children may also qualify for the extended entitlement (30 hours).

The date you can claim will depend on when your child's birthday is.

**Child's birthday:**

1 Jan – 31 Mar

1 Apr – 31 Aug

1 Sep – 31 Dec

**Start date:**

the beginning of the term on or after 1 April

the beginning of the term on or after 1 September

the beginning of the term on or after 1 January
