Funding

2 year olds - Some children qualify for government funding (15 hours) of free education from the age of two.

3 & 4 year olds - All children from the age of three qualify for the universal entitlement (15 hours) of free education.

Some children may also qualify for the extended entitlement (30 hours).

The date you can claim will depend on when your child's birthday is.

Child's birthday:

1 Jan – 31 Mar

1 Apr – 31 Aug

1 Sep – 31 Dec

Start date:

the beginning of the term on or after 1 April

the beginning of the term on or after 1 September

the beginning of the term on or after 1 January
